Activity Corner: Earth Day

Earth Day is a time of year to do your part in taking care of the planet. Whether its by planting trees or even recycling, there are many ways to help our planet. Here is an activity you can do with your kids!

Cardboard Tube Bird Feeder



What you need: String, Scissors, String, Birdseed, butter knife, Sun butter, Bamboo Skewers and paper towel roll.

Steps:

- 1. Cut two holes at the top and bottom of the cardboard tube.
- 2. Push the bamboo skewer through the bottom holes as a perch for birds to stand on.
- 3. Spread sun butter throughout the outside of the tube.
- 4. Pour birdseed onto a plate and roll the tube in the seeds until it is completely covered.
- 5. Thread twine into the top holes and hang outside.
